**Primary 7 Leaving Celebration.**

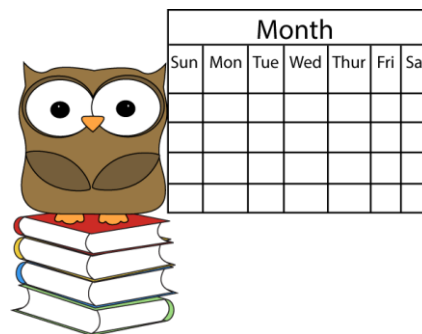
