

<u>Absence</u>. Attendance at school is vital for your child to achieve their potential in learning. Hopefully your child will be healthy and be in school every day. If your child is unwell, <u>please notify the school office on 0141 634 5861</u>. If for any reason your child is not in school and we have not had notification about their absence, the office staff will contact you to ask about the absence. Holidays within the school term are discouraged.

#### Medication.

If your child requires essential medication during the school day, please call in at the office where we will ask you to complete a form giving us the appropriate information and authority to administer medicines.

All medication must be prescribed for your child and have the pharmacy sticker with your child's details on it.

### FIRST AID

Minor mishaps such as a fall in the playground are dealt with by the support staff. A note will be given to your child to inform you of the bump or fall or we will call you.

Asthma If your child requires an inhaler for asthma, we ask that they carry their inhaler with them at all times. (A good life skill!) Please send a spare inhaler, clearly marked with your child's name and dosage details into the school office and we will keep that as a spare in case of loss/emergency.

### Letters/ Permisssion Slips

Please check your child's bag each night and return any forms etc to school as soon as possible. Chasing up "forgotten" permission slips etc is very time consuming for our office staff. It is essential that all children going out of school on any visits/ trips have written permission.

We appreciate you assistance with this.

## Personal Belongings - Lost Property.

Please ensure that all shoes, items of clothing, school bags, lunch boxes and pencil cases have your child's full name marked on them. We have a much better chance of returning lost belongings if they have a name on them! There is presently a huge amount of lost property. If your child has lost an item please call into the school office. Thanks
