The Nursery, Primary 1 and Primary 2 children are performing the Nativity on Monday 21st December and at the School Christmas Service on Tuesday 22nd December. The Monday performance is especially for Nursery, Primary 1 and Primary 2 families and we would like to invite you all along at 1:30pm for this. Again a reminder that the morning children are again asked to switch to the afternoon session on Monday 21st December (1pm).

<u>Christmas Party</u>

The Nursery Christmas Party will take place on Friday 18th December 10am-2pm. All children are invited to attend for the full four hours as this will be a joint Morning and Afternoon party. We will have a variety of games, activities, snacks and a special
