If your child attends nursery in the afternoons their trip will be Monday pm; and if your child attends in the mornings their trip will be Tuesday am. If your child attends full time we have incorporated them based on the days they stay full time. Information letters/ permission forms will be issued this week.

To allow us to do so we are inviting you to come along for a short 'Outdoor Stay and Play'. We will then issue a short questionnaire to determine what you and your child would like to see added to our outdoor area. On both days the garden will be open from 11:30am-11:55am (for morning session families) and from 3:40pm-4:05pm (for afternoon session families). We hope you are able to make it!
