Winter Bugs

It's that time of year again when the children return to nursery and during winter can catch a variety of bugs and infections. We would ask that you continue to highlight the importance of hand washing to your children and general hygiene rules to limit the spread of any germs. We have been doing this in nursery and will continue to do so. If your child has any symptoms such as high temperature, headache, sickness, sore throat or a rash please let nursery staff know and seek appropriate medical attention if required.

Adverse Weather

Unfortunately this time of year also brings some adverse weather conditions which we have been experiencing lately. We appreciate that it can be cold and wet outside in the morning before nursery begins. We have investigated any options and the only area we can provide is the sheltered space outside directly outside the nursery. Due to insurance purposes and for health and safety we are unable to open the corridor up before 9am. We would encourage you where possible to bring your child to nursery as close to the 9am bell to limit any time outside in poor weather.

Snack Money



Thank you to everyone who contributes regularly to our snack fund. We really do appreciate and rely upon this to provide healthy and balanced snacks for the children at nursery. Can we remind parents that all children have a wallet with their name on it which can be found in the corridor and would encourage you to contribute £2.50 per week.
