Breakfast Club

We have a Breakfast Club which provides a <u>free</u> breakfast of toast, cereal and juice in our dinner hall between 8.15 and 8.45am every morning. This is available to <u>all</u> children in school and there is no need to register. The children are supervised by school staff in the Breakfast Club. The children go into the playground at 8.45am for a short play before the bell rings at 9am. This is supervised by one or two members of support staff. We ask that children are not dropped off before 8.15am.

Attendance and Time Keeping

Attendance and Time Keeping letters are sent regularly (we are required to send regular updates to parents). Good attendance at school is vital for your child to reach their full potential. If they are not at school, they are missing valuable learning experiences. Punctuality is also crucial as every minute in school is "Learning Time." Please try to get your child here on time to come into school with their line at 9.00a.m. If your child is late, they will be able to come into the school via their class door up until 9.05am. After this time, they will have to sign in at the School Office and will be marked late. We appreciate your support with this. A wee five minutes late every day adds up to over 16 hours of missed learning over a school year!
