School Uniform


The children are looking very smart in their school uniforms. Thank you for your continued support in encouraging the children to wear their Spittal uniform with pride. Please ensure your child is sent with **FULL** school uniform, should you be missing a few items or need some help, we have our FREE uniform rack that can be found within the school office 'bubble' or please phone/email the school with sizes and we will secure what we can. Please note, if your child loses anything throughout the day it will be on our Lost Property rack at 3pm, at the GP Room door beside Room 2.

Attendance and Time Keeping

Good attendance at school is vital for your child to reach their full potential (our school vision). If they are not at school, they are missing valuable learning experiences. Punctuality is also crucial as every minute in school is "Learning Time." Please try to get your child here on time to come into school with their line at 9.00am. If your child is late, they will be able to come into the school via their class door up until 9.05.am. After this time, they will have to sign in at the School Office. We appreciate your support with this. *A wee five minutes late every day adds up to over 16 hours of missed learning over a school year!*

As always, regular updates/letters are sent out specific to families... so please look out for these and respond as stated on the letter.

Please maximise attendance: aiming for 95% or more will minimise the impact on your child's learning.

<u>New members of Team Spittal - Nursery</u> – We welcome 2 full-time permanent members of staff to Spittal Nursery Class. Both, successful at interview. We also welcome (officially) Miss Maria Sherry (Early Years Excellence and Equity Lead) to our nursery who is focussed on nursery improvement ideas. All have already made a valued contribution to Team Spittal, welcome and thank you.

<u>Placing Requests / Primary 1 induction (new entrant) information</u> – Placing request outcomes are due to parents on 28th April, if you have not received this – please check your emails and/or contact the nursery/school for more information.

We have re-launched our Primary 1 induction programme and the details are (as below), parents will receive a letter and phone call from Miss Rennie to confirm dates and times:

Induction Day 1 - Thursday 15th May @ 1.30-2.30pm – welcome event with parents and children.

Induction Day 2 – Tuesday 20th May @ 9.30-10.30am – children only session with class activity.

Induction Day 3 – Thursday 29th May @ 11.30-12.15pm – school lunch taster session with parents and children.

Induction Day 4 – Wednesday 4th June @ 1.30-2.30pm – children only session with class activity.

Induction Day 5 – Tuesday 10th June @ 9.30-10.30am – Tour of school and Meet P7 buddy session with parents and children.

<u>Class configurations for session 2025-26</u> – this will not be known until much later in the session. We do know that we will have 7 classes and a nursery class next year. Some years we only have 6 classes and a nursery class, but our numbers are strong for the forthcoming session, however we often do not find out about staffing/teachers until the last few weeks of term as staffing entitlement and allocation (to the school) is decided upon by South Lanarkshire Council, not the school.

<u>Our School and Nursery Summer Show</u> – Spittal PS and NC will be performing a school summer show on 3rd June 2025 at 9.30am and 1.30pm (*dates and time subject to change*). The chosen theme is musicals/songs from TV/film and plans are underway already with class songs being heard throughout the corridors already – it looks to be a sell-out, so keep an eye on

the school app for more information – tickets are not on sale yet.

<u>School Closures/Holidays</u> – Our final Inservice Day will be held on <u>Thursday 1st May</u> and as this is a staff training day, the school will be <u>closed</u> to all pupils across the school and nursery. School <u>re-opens on Friday 2nd May 2025</u>. The May Day Bank Holiday on <u>Monday 5th May</u> means the school is closed to all students and school <u>re-opens on Tuesday 6th May</u>.
